- This is a rain or shine event;
- There is a non-refundable \$25.00 vendor cancellation fee. No refunds will be given 30 days prior to the event unless authorized by the OLFF committee;
- The festival policy is one vendor per booth. If you would like to share your venue and/or "double up," permission must be given by the OLFF committee and two applications, one per vendor, must be submitted;
- OLFF reserves the right to make changes in the floor plan, but not after the beginning of vendor set-up;
- Early set-up is available by reservation on Friday, September 13th from 2:00 pm 8:00 pm. If you plan to set up on Friday, please contact Dana (danaknits@aol.com) to be added to the Friday set up schedule. Open set-up is Saturday, September 14th from 7:00 am to 9:00 am.;
- Vendors need to remain set up from 8:30 am 4:00 pm on Saturday, September 14th, 2019;
- Vendors are responsible for all unpacking, erecting, dismantling and repacking displays;
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting Virginia sales/use tax. Please see online State of Virginia Sales & Use Tax information at http://www.tax.virginia.gov/site.cfm?alias=salesusetax or you may call Virginia Department of Taxation at 804-367-8037;
- Vendors bringing their fiber animals must provide their own cage(s) and, for the safety of the public and other fiber animals attending the faire, a current certificate of veterinary inspection meeting the requirements of Virginia on an approved form of the state of origin. - No pets are allowed. Certified service dogs, or service dogs in training, are permitted;
- Vendors must be ready to leave by 6:00 pm Saturday and
